Education Programs

Topics: The current programs at the Wetland Center focus on:
Wetland Ecology; field and lab studies, water quality, macro invertebrate collection and identification, soil survey and plant identification.
Bird Adaptations; field and lab studies, bird identification, use of binoculars and field guides, and review of migration patterns
Stewardship; introduction and conclusion activities that inspire students to learn more about how to protect fragile wetland ecosystems.
