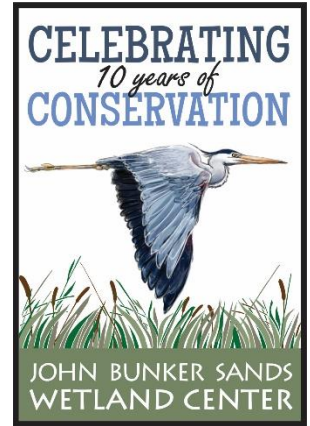


JBS Craft Corner

Tin Can Crafts – Bird Feeder

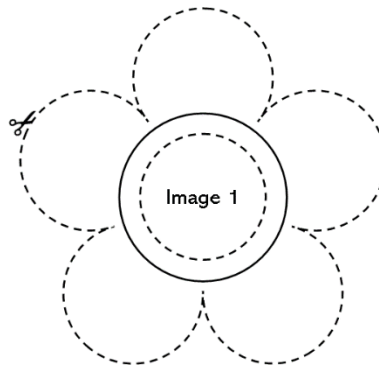


Supplies

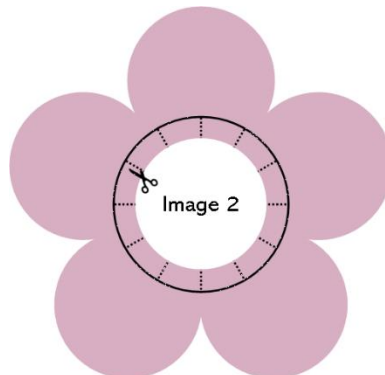
- Tin can
- Scissors
- Craft foam
- Hemp string
- Wooden dowel
- Pen or pencil
- Paint and brushes
- Hot glue gun and hot glue sticks
- Bird seed of your choice

Instructions

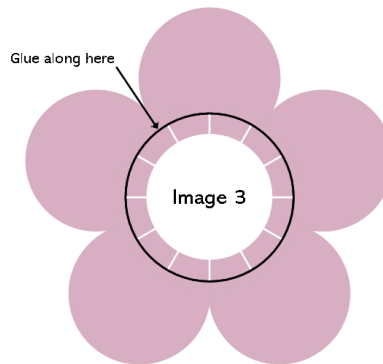
1. Trace the opening of the can on craft foam and then trace a circle inside about a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch smaller. Then draw some flower petals around the larger circle. (See image 1.)
2. Cut out the flower and then cut out the smaller inside circle. (See image 1.)



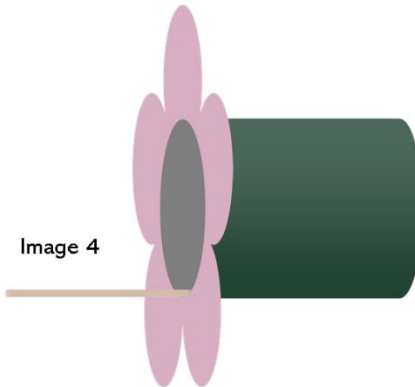
3. Next cut some tabs out from the inner opening to the edge of the larger circle. (See image 2.)



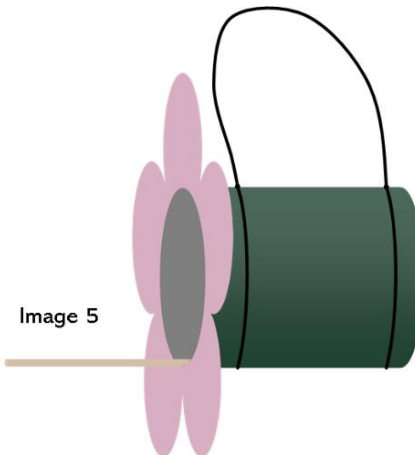
4. Paint the outside of the can to your preference and let dry.
5. Lay the flower face down, apply some hot glue around the larger circle on the foam flower and press the opening of the can down into the hot glue. (*See image 3.*)



6. Hot glue each of the tabs down against the inner wall of the can.
7. Hot glue a wooden dowel along the inner wall of the can. (*See image 4.*)



8. Wrap some string around the can to create a hanger. (*See image 5.*)



9. Fill the can with bird seed and hang outside.
