



American Bald Eagles

Monitoring & Relocation Timeline

- 2008 - 2010**
 - Adult Bald Eagle activity observed in the Wetland
 - No nesting activity observed in the Wetland
 - Juvenile Bald Eagles observed with adults
- Fall 2011 - Winter 2012**
 - Bald Eagle nesting activity on the existing Oncor tower
 - Juvenile Bald Eagles observed with adults
- Spring 2012**
 - Adult Bald Eagles leave Wetland
- Fall 2012 - Winter 2013**
 - Pair of Bald Eagles arrive back in Wetland
 - Courting & nest building behavior observed on the existing Oncor tower
 - 2 Eaglets observed in the existing nest
- Spring 2013**
 - Adult Bald Eagles hunting and feeding their young
 - 2 Eaglets observed growing and strengthening
- May 2013**
 - Partnership forms between Oncor, Falcon Steel and the Wetland Center for continued monitoring and eventual safe relocation of the eagle nest to Wetland property
- June 2013**
 - 2 Eaglets fledge the nest and flourish in the Wetland
- Summer 2013**
 - Adult Eagles & Juvenile Eagles leave Wetland
 - Plans move forward for relocation
- September 2013**
 - Adult Eagles return early - relocation efforts postponed
 - Bird deterrents installed by Oncor on adjacent tower structures
- Fall 2013 - Winter 2014**
 - Observation of Adult Bald Eagles and nesting behavior continues over breeding season
- Spring 2014**
 - Hopeful of new eaglets from adult Bald Eagles
- Summer 2014**
 - Continued monitoring with Oncor's staff of biologists for eventual relocation of Eagle nest to new tower structure
